Anthony J. Mejia was appointed City Clerk of the City of Palm Springs, California, by the City Manager in December 2017, and has over 14 years of experience in local government. He is a graduate of Continuing Education for Public Officials and Technical Training for Clerks. Anthony earned his Certified Municipal Clerk designation by the International Institute of Municipal Clerks in 2010 and was certified as a Master Municipal Clerk in 2014. Anthony previously served as City Clerk for the communities of South Pasadena, San Luis Obispo, and Pomona.

Anthony currently serves as the 2nd Vice President of the City Clerks Association of California (CCAC). Previous service includes CCAC Regional Director for Los Angeles County, Athenian Dialogue Coordinator, Legislative Committee Member, and Southern Division President and Treasurer. Anthony also served as the Chairman of the Public Relations and Marketing Committee for the International Institute of Municipal Clerks.

Anthony has led trainings regarding the Public Records Act, Ralph M. Brown Act, ethical decision making, increasing diversity on Boards and Commissions, and implementation of SB 415 regarding election year cycles. Anthony is an IIMC-approved facilitator for Athenian Leadership Dialogues, in which participants are required to read books and actively participate in six-hour facilitator led discussions tying the books to leadership principles and the City Clerk profession.

In 2017, Anthony received the CCAC Presidential Special Award of Distinction. He was previously a recipient of the CCAC Award of Distinction for Organization, Administration, and Communication and was named City Clerk of the Year for Southern California.
